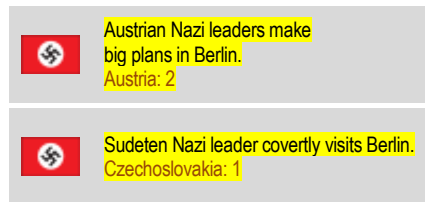


## *Is this a good time to talk?*

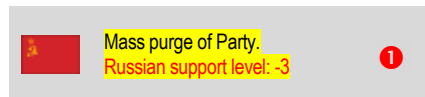
In Winter 1939, near the end of an eventful game, Germany goes for Poland and the Allies can't oppose it. Germany opts for a Pact with Russia.

Given the random events, it seems this time the talks took place in Berlin, not Moscow.

The two German diplomatic events have the Austrian and Sudetenland leaders coming to Berlin. Since both Austria and Czechoslovakia are under German control, these both convert to support events, giving Germany a +3 support bonus:



As if this wasn't enough, Stalin decides this is a perfect time to clean house:



As it happens, the other Pact modifiers balance out, so the end result is a 25-level Pact, courtesy of the 6-point shift from the random events result and Germany's impeccable timing.
